Folia-IQ Cu is designed for use as foliar fertilizer in crops deficient in copper and is non-toxic when used in compliance with label instructions. For best results, apply Folia-IQ Cu according to plant tissue analysis and recommendations from a local agronomist.

**Mixing and Application Directions:**

Folia-IQ Cu can be used with most adjuvants, pesticides and nutrients in a regular crop management program. Check compatibility by mixing all spray tank components in a small jar test. Also ensure that the guidelines for all tank mix partners are being followed and check for specific mentions of antagonism, incompatibility or phytotoxicity risk with fertilizer blends. Add specified quantities of Folia-IQ Cu into the spray mix solution per table and footnotes below. The maximum application of copper according to the corresponding local laws must also be followed.

The dosages below are generally safe and should only be used as a general reference. Certain tank mixes under various circumstances may cause injury to the crop. Consider chemical, physical, biological and plant compatibility properties of such mixes prior to making applications on a broad commercial scale. Apply by spray method (ground rig or airplane) and in an adequate volume of water that will provide complete coverage of the plants. Please make sure a non-ionic wetting agent is in the mixture to be applied.

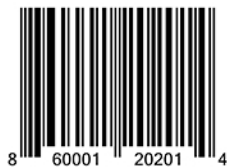
